Bless your servants whom you have called to be councillors in this parish." lay hand upon the head of each person to be commissioned in turn "Pour out your Holy Spirit to X.. whom we in your name commission as a councillor"

"Give them grace to do the work committed to them and vision to lead your people in their witness to the world. Make them constant in service and wise in counsel grounded in the love of your Son, Jesus Christ, that through them your will may be done and your name may be glorified"

All respond Amen.
